## **I-JOBS Review Committee, Board plan upcoming meetings**

*Review Committee meets August 26 in Urbandale, Board meets August 31 in Waterloo*

DES MOINES – The Review Committee of the I-JOBS Board of Directors will meet tomorrow in Urbandale to review the first of several applications for funds from the competitive portion of the Local Infrastructure Program of Governor Culver’s I-JOBS initiative.

The Local Infrastructure Program includes \$165 million in funds for disaster recovery and prevention and local infrastructure. Of that, \$118.5 million is available on a competitive basis.
