

I-JOBS Signage Requirements

All projects that receive I-JOBS funding are required to produce and display an I-JOBS sign during the project's construction period.

- Signage is not required for road and bridge projects.
- If a project includes multiple locations, only one sign is required. That sign should be placed at the location that has the greatest public visibility.
- Signage is not required for owner-occupied housing rehabilitation.
- Signage is not required for domestic violence shelters or other locations that must keep their location confidential.
- Signage is not required for loan programs such as loans for alternative energy.

The State of Iowa provides the electronic art and sign specifications for grantees to send to the sign company/printer of their choice. Or grantees may consider using [Iowa Prison Industries](#) to produce the signs. Grantees must pay for sign production and must erect the sign. Grantees may choose from a horizontal or vertical sign option.

The horizontal and vertical EPS files are zipped and available for download. They have been created to the exact dimensions and are high resolution (300 dpi.) PDF versions are also available for reference.

Sign specifications are:

Board materials:

¾" Plywood A-B Ext. APA (Or comparable material)

Size:

48" x 60" vertical or 60" x 48" horizontal

Colors:

Light green: Pantone 384

(4C Separation: 18c, 0m, 100y, 31k)

Dark green: 4C Separation: 65c, 55m, 100y, 28k

Font usage:

There are only two areas of text that are editable on the electronic files. All other text is set in place and cannot be edited.

1. Project name
Arial Narrow, minimum font size 300pt, black
2. Dollar amount funded
Arial Narrow, minimum font size 275pt, black
