Dear Mr. Drew:

The State of Iowa received your notification of intent to apply for I-JOBS funding on, July 30, 2009. In accordance with Iowa Jobs Program 265-32.4(5)(f), *the application must coordinate any federal funds with state, local, and private funds and shall avoid any duplication of benefits that would limit or cause the loss of federal funding.* To insure there will be no duplication benefits, the State requests that the applicant submit the below information for review:

- Identification of potential projects that will be receiving both Federal Public Assistance Funding and I-JOBS Funding (please include FEMA Project Worksheet Numbers)
- Detailed Scope of Work pertaining to projects that the applicant wishes to complete utilizing I-JOBS Funding

After receipt of the above information the State will further review the potential for a duplication of benefits and report findings to the Iowa Finance Authority.
